BACKGROUND:

On May 20th, Cobide Engineering Inc. received four (4) tenders for the Brook Street West Storm Sewer Design project. Based on the, the lowest Tender received for the project which was submitted by Kurtis Smith Excavating. This Tender is approximately \$198,000 higher than the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie budget submitted for the project in the fall of 2020.

COMMENTS:

In discussion with Travis Burnside from Cobide Engineering (see attached letter). Increases in constructions costs due to COVID-19, material shortages as well as increased labour costs due to additional safety measures contributed to the

tender price being higher than the estimate.

Travis is recommending that the Tender be cancelled for this year. Cancelling the project for this year and re-tendering early next year will allow for the municipality to budget for additional funds to complete the project and may also improve the chances of getting a better price.
